She has learned to accept herself and realise that we are all different, in spite of the illusion that we are all the same shape size and that there exists a dominate group within the human race.

Marcia is keen to empower others to find their voice, working from a place of acceptance and self-love, which Marcia herself has had to invest in, in order to achieve, as she was always told what she cannot do, rather than what she can.






